Round 10 OVER HALF WAY



We are well over half way into the 2011 season and what a year we've had. Cyclones, rain, break-ins, water inundation and fire just to name a few. The damage has been plentiful including roof, tree, shade shelter, pavers, equipment and fields. With the delayed start to the season and the hold-up in getting insurance payouts the repair process has been some what slow and tedious. However, we having been looking long term and decisions and priorities have been based on not just 'repairing' but to 'repair & improve' in the process.

Work completed includes the drainage and pavers around the administration/canteen building. These pavers have been completely removed and re-levelled.

Work currently underway includes improvement to drainage in the Fields 10(A-D) area of the complex, behind the canteen. These fields were extensively damaged due to excess water sitting on the fields over a long period of time. In addition, the whole area is being re-levelled and three fields will be constructed in this area. One full size field and two junior size fields.

Proposed future work includes the roof replacement and rewiring of the administration building.

Finally the new ticket box at the RSL Stadium end of the field will be opening soon. We will keep you posted on our web site.

As always, please be patient with the ongoing work and repairs around the complex. We ask parents and officials be alert to children breaking tree branches that are trying to re-establish themselves and children climbing on gardens, goal posts and nets. We thank you for your assistance.
